## **Christmas Joy Delivered**

Our Lord is faithful. With the help of our ministry partners, we were able to provide a variety of food, clothes, toys, and household items to the poverty stricken region of Eastern Kentucky. Prayers were answered for the residents of this region through our December coat and toy distribution, as well as our monthly food distribution held in early December.

December 3rd was a day that many individuals came together to deliver joy to many food pantries to distribute to children and youth during Christmas. Some partners in our ministry focused their efforts on the teenagers of Eastern Kentucky. The teenagers age group had cosmetic bags, makeup, hats, and a variety of little gifts that would help these teens know that someone is thinking



of them. Often times teenagers are overlooked at Christmas time when a majority of the focus is on the young, but that was not the case this year. Our prayers were answered when over 350 coats, 500 toys, 250 new pairs of shoes along with a variety of hats, gloves and gifts were given away at our annual December coat

and toy distribution. Over 30 volunteers came together from both Illinois and the local Stanton Christian Church, to make the day a resounding success. We have already started collecting coats for next Christmas by setting up a collection site at our local True Value to collect coats in good condition that we can deliver to Kentucky.
