We had an opportunity to visit Pastor Anthony at his County Line Community Church food pantry. Pastor Anthony picks up for 5 food agencies, including his own. This saves over an hour drive each way for the other agencies in his area.



County Line Pantry is operated by County Line Community Church and is located in Hazard, Kentucky. The pantry serves 1,800 people annually in Perry County of Eastern Kentucky.

In November the church was able to distribute food to over a hundred households affecting nearly 200 individuals. County Line gave out food totaling over \$12,000.

The age breakdown of those receiving assistance:

- 49 Children (0 - 17)
- 69 Adults (18 - 59)
- 81 Seniors (60+)

County Line is showing God's love by providing life-saving meals to the hungry families of Perry County Kentucky.
