Thanksgiving is behind us and Christmas is just a few short weeks away but lets take a moment to reflect on what we have to be thankful for. The blessings that our ministry has received this year are answers to the prayers of many. We were able to erect donated steel shelving to help eliminate bottlenecks in the warehouse during distribution. We added a nice heater to the warehouse to keep the food and volunteers warm during the cold winter months. We had four additional pallet jacks donated which allow us to operate more efficiently and replace a couple older jacks. Each month we are blessed with a wonderful group of volunteers that come from Illinois, Kentucky and Wisconsin. Our volunteers are people that dedicate a few hours a month to help with the food distribution. That is what Jesus meant by "love thy neighbor". The Bible tells us "Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and He will reward them for what they have done" (Proverbs 19:17, NIV). All of these are blessings for which we are truly thankful.

Sometimes it's hard for us to imagine that there are many people out there that have little or nothing to eat. Each month we have the opportunity to help these people by bringing 5,000 to 6,000 cases of food and supplies from Illinois to 36 food assistance agencies in Eastern Kentucky. This would not be possible without our outstanding partnership with Midwest Food Bank



(MFB). MFB provides blessings not only to our ministry, but distributes over \$18 million worth of food to over 1,700 non-profit organizations each month. If you would like more information visit <u>midwestfoodbank.org.</u>

Jackson County Food Bank

In November we had an opportunity to visit Jackson County Food Bank located in McKee, KY. Jackson County Food Bank is managed by Director, Joyce Marks. Joyce has operated the food bank since the beginning, 33 years ago. Joyce is assisted by a small, but dedicated group of volunteers and her son-in-law, Henry, makes the two hour trip each month to pick up food. Jackson County Food Bank serves over 900 people each month with emergency food and supplies.
