## 2024 JR'S SPRING LOCAL RULES

- Light code 270001 #on/\* off. NOZOMI PARK 250 S Kyrene Rd. Lighting touchpad is located at the NE corner of restrooms on the big gray box on wall of restrooms.
- PAPAGO PARK LOCATED AT 1000 N COLLEGE AVE, TEMPE 85281 lights come on automatically. Call Tempe South Pres. Chris Coronella 602-299-5581 if an issue arises with field or lights he holds the permits at Papago Park.
- Papago Park has a temp mound. Soft spikes must be worn by the pitcher while pitching. NO METAL. It tears the turf.
- 4. At Papago the foul lines and batters box are "PAINTED" no chalk is to be used. Paint and sprayer located in centerfield shed. The temp mound is to be left at the fence line at first base dugout once last game has ended.
- After the last game has ended. Please make sure all equipment is placed back in the shed and the shed is locked.
- 6. At least 1 adult in dugout at all times.
- Managers are the only ones to officially interact with umpire during play.
- All managers and coaches to remain in the dugout while team is in the field. Close 1st and 3rd gates at dugout during play.
- 9. Inter-League rules to be used. Your league ASAP plan must be followed.
- 10. Home team is official score/pitch count. Visiting team please verify pitch count at pitcher change and end of game.
- Game time 1:45 no new inning...2:00 Drop Dead...game stops...if inning is not completed. Previous innings score will be the official score for the game if the drop dead is reached.
- 12. Run rule... (15) after 3 ½ innings... (10) runs after 4 ½... (8) after 5 ½ innings if home team is ahead.
- 13. The umpires keep official game clock. If an inning end at 1:44, start new inning 1:45 and beyond game ends. The umpires are not there to MAKE you lose. Please keep a sportsmanship attitude with the umpires. Un-sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated by either team or the umpires.
- 14. Managers are responsible for their <u>players/coaches/spectators</u>. Keep them in line your managing ability is on the line.
- 15. MANAGERS: YOU MUST CONTROL YOUR PARENTS/SPECTATORS/PLAYERS, IF THEY ARE EJECTED YOU MAY BE REMOVED
  AS WELL.
- 16. Player must have a catcher's glove and a mask to warm up catcher. All players SHOULD be wearing a...cup/support...<u>Catcher's "MUST" have a CUP while catching no cup no play...</u>on deck hitter retrieves foul balls. <u>No donuts</u> "ONLY" sleeve type weights can be used. <u>Dangling throat guards</u> must be worn by catcher.
- 17. Continuous batting order. You may start with 8 players additional player will be added to the bottom of the order. NO Out will be recorded for the missed "9th slot". Player shows up late they are added to bottom. Mandatory play is in effect unless game is shortened. Get them their innings they want to play.
- 18. 2024 Rule book...use it...Courtesy runner may be used for the catcher with 2 outs. Closest previous batter to catcher.
- 19. Home team dresses the field. Visitors break down and store equipment. Unless there is another game after yours. Visiting team is encouraged to assist with field prep...keep it fair it gets hot out there Help them out...
- Ties if inning is not completed at 1:45. Continue until a winner is crowned or you reach the 2:00 drop dead. If still tied
  previous innings score to be used. If that score is tied. Then a tie it is.
- 18. Any field or safety concerns please send them to me.
- 19. Standings will be kept by Chuck Sabbatt. He is the retired ALL manager. He loves the game and wants to support it in any way he can. All scores reported at the completion of the game. Don't make him hunt them down. The end of season Playoffs will be the top 8 teams. The 9th seed will be eliminated from playoff contention. Single elimination tournament will be played with top 8 seeds.
- 20. If for some reason the game has no umpires. Each team will provide on umpire behind pitcher's mound. While opposing team is up to bat. Do your best. Relax and have fun with it. Be as fair and impartial as possible.
- 21. Home team supplies 2 new balls per game. Visitors supply 2 used game ready balls per game.
- 22. Any Decision that effects the game being played re: venue, field conditions/safety, lights etc. It will be at the umpire's discretion. Please contact Bryan Goodman # below.
