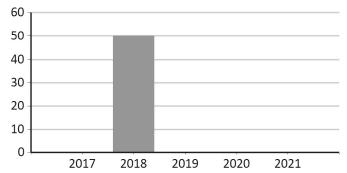

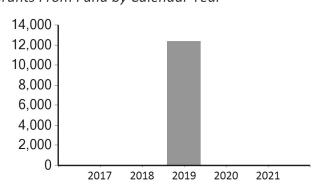
YOUR GENEROSITY Gifts Into Fund by Calendar Year

Gifts Into Fund by Calendar Year



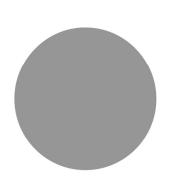
YOUR IMPACT
