6:55 pm – Girls Varsity HS 5K Race (30 minute cut-off time)

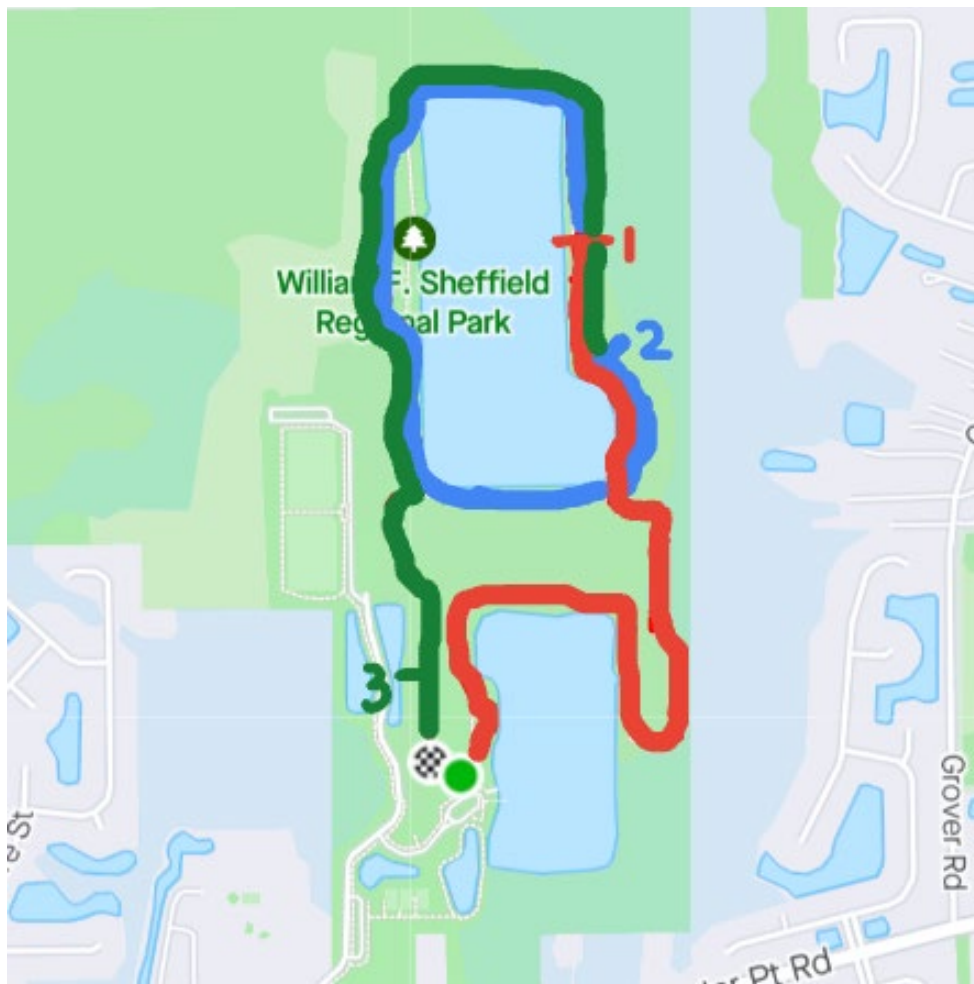
Awards

Course Map

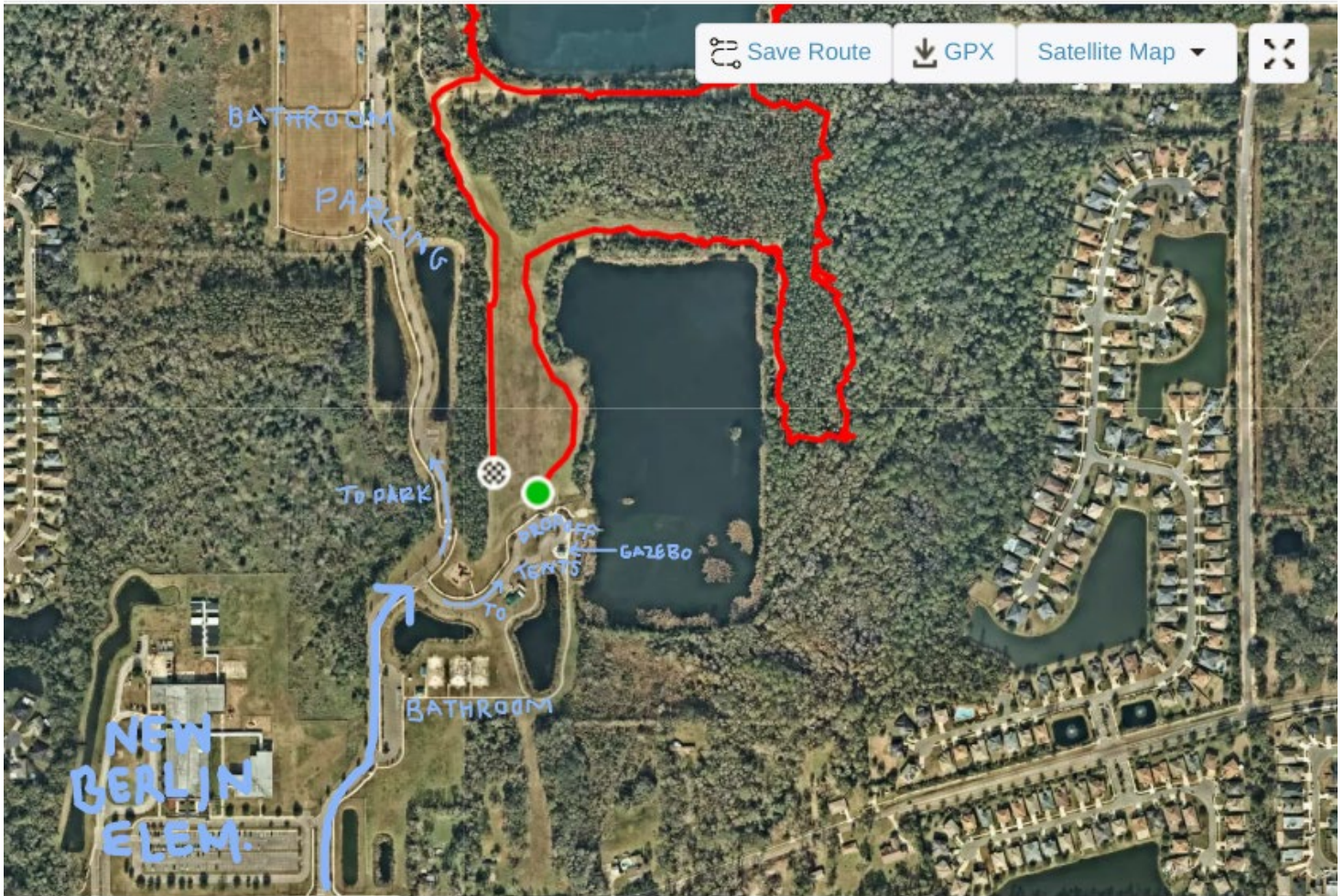


Information for Coaches and Parents
