6:55 pm - Girls Varsity Race (30 minute cut-off time)

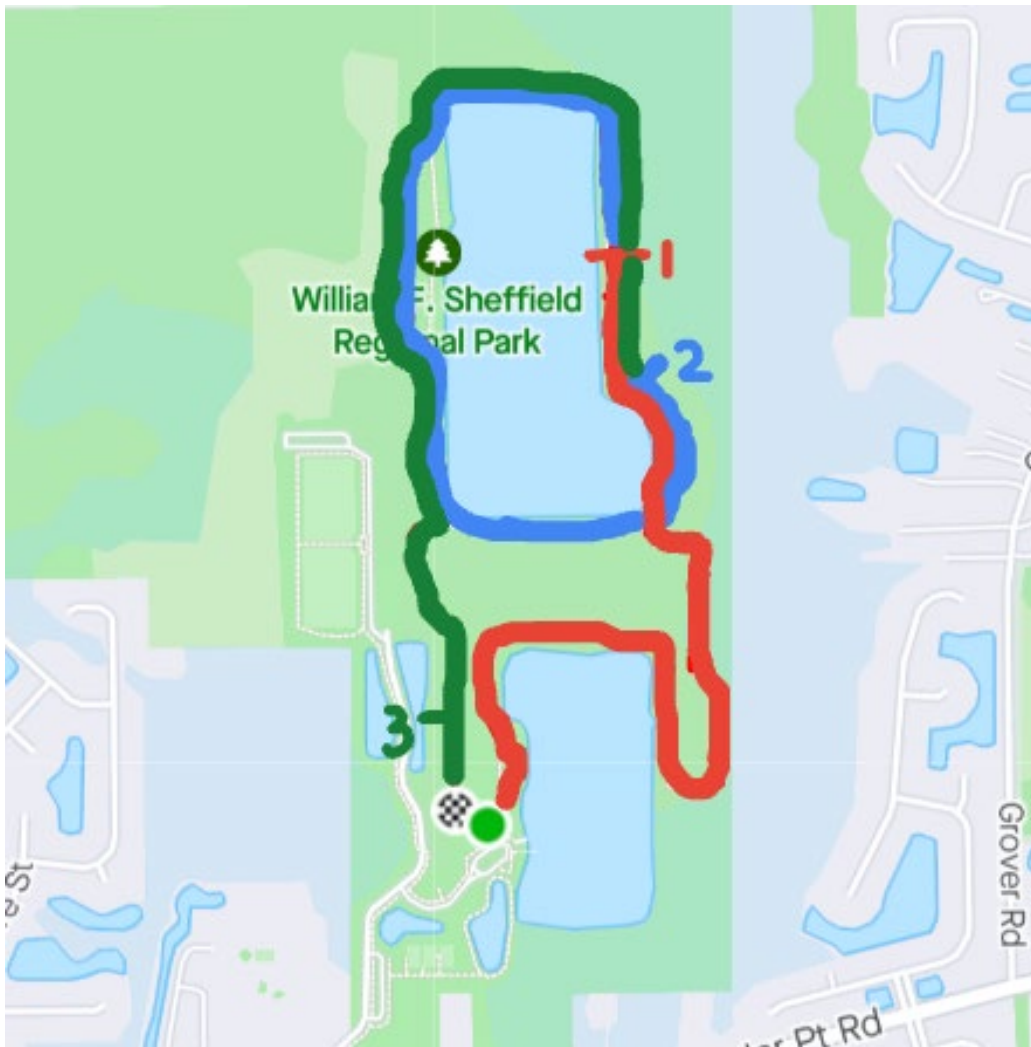
## Awards

## Course Map

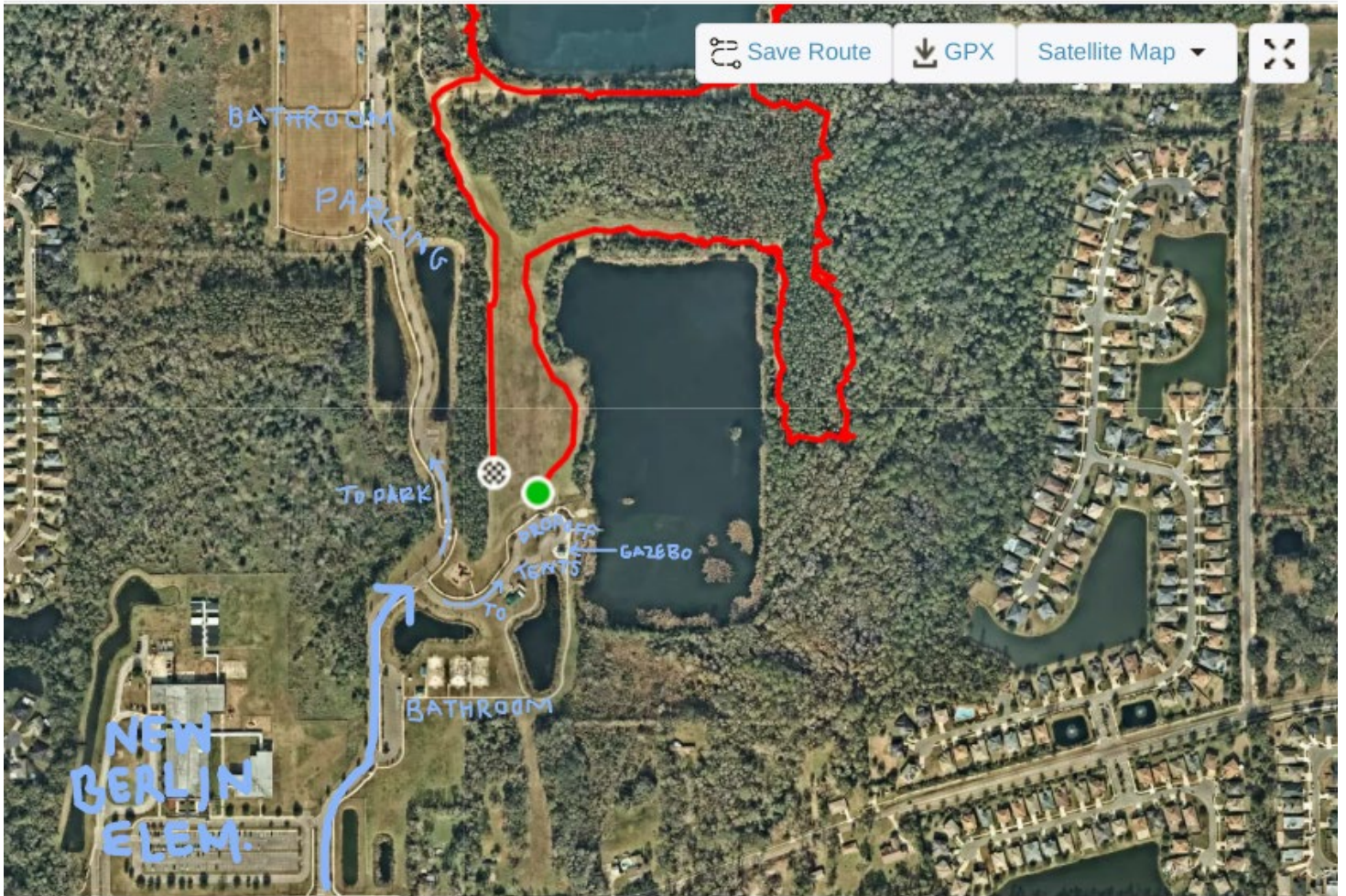


## Information for Coaches and Parents
