I am currently learning different teaching methods that I can implement in the class to help students learn in a fun way. The following is a list of some of the milestone's children aged three would be expected to meet:

- takes turns during a game
- shows concern for a crying friend
- dresses & undresses self
- understands position words
- says first name, age, & gender
- has 2-3 sentence conversations
- strangers can understand speech
- completes 3-4 piece puzzles
- turns book pages 1 at a time
- runs easily
- climbs well

Please remember that all children learn at different paces, so if a student hasn't mastered a milestone, we can work together to get him/her ready for the next steps. I will be sending a more complete list of milestones in the weekly folders soon. In addition to the above-mentioned, we will celebrate some pretty special events soon. Dr. Seuss birthday is the first of these events happening on March 1, followed by St. Patrick's Day on March 17, and Easter on March 31. Please be on the lookout for notices about these events. ## Noteworthy News Mrs. Joanna Everyone

The Caterpillars, Butterflies, and Wild Ones will continue to hear nursery rhymes, folk songs, classical music, children's music, and popular music. I play a small set of bongos while singing songs to help reinforce the steady beat. The babies will continue exploring with an age-appropriate rhythm instrument and even the bongos. The Little Garden, Clubhouse, Space, Elephant, and Farm Rooms will be focusing on tempo (fast and slow). Our lessons have a transportation theme. The children are learning to control and coordinate their body's movements by getting faster or slower and stopping and starting. They are also going to focus on the concept of up and down. Music moves up and down and we will explore that with our bodies and voices (speaking, singing, vocalizing, and listening). The Pre-K

classes will use their imaginations while moving around to music and singing songs. We build a pretend boat and sail on the sea, keeping a steady beat as we do this. We will have fun dancing like twinkling stars and use active listening skills to determine that the same song was sang by a man and hummed by a woman. The children will also listen to identify some of the instruments they hear in the song. We will continue to work on keeping a steady beat and inhibitory control.
