I use a lot of repetition which is very important for learning at this age. I can tell when they have started to remember hearing a song or rhyme and which ones they prefer. This makes me smile! The Little Garden, Clubhouse, Space, Elephant, and Farm Rooms are using fine and gross motor skills while working on concepts such as up and down. We will also explore smooth and bumpy. We are having so much fun with this by pretending to use different forms of transportation. We have pretended to be a train; will use our hands and whole bodies to fly like an airplane; and will move our bodies like we are floating down the river in a boat. Music class is always more fun when we get to dance with scarves and explore playing different rhythm instruments. I love seeing the smiles and joy that these activities bring to your children! The Pre-K classes are going to continue to practice their singing voices and learn the difference between using words to sing a song and humming a song. We will practice singing while dancing to specific movements. We will also work on inhibitory control using rhythm instruments while singing a song in a foreign language.
