

A WORD FROM PASTOR TIM Pentecost for our Church

God be with you!

This month, along with the church around the world, we celebrate Pentecost - the day the Holy Spirit fell upon the disciples. "And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability" (Acts 2).

The result of the Holy Spirit's entrance was the 1) praise of God, 2) powerful proclamation of Jesus, the one God sent, 3) the sharing of gifts, 4) and prayer for the good of all. (see Acts 2:41-47) In worship on May 19th, we will remember this Pentecost and celebrate our sharing of gifts for the sake of the Gospel God has given us. We will take time to hear from our graduating seniors about their hopes for the future and gift them a quilt made from our church to be a blessing.

After Pentecost, the church grew with the anointing of God and had to expand its ministry. Later in the month, we will move our worship to include Green Lake Stave Chapel and offer ongoing worship here at our Faith campus. All of this is a sign of the Holy Spirit's ongoing work in our midst.
