'Japanese Art and the West: From Namban to Japonaiserie' Lecture: Marie Conte-Helm

This lecture will chart the artistic relationship between Japan and the West beginning with the Namban or golden screen paintings of 'southern barbarians' that reflected the presence of Portuguese Jesuits in 16th century Nagasaki. Japan's subsequent isolationism and limited contact with the outside world through the Dutch trade produced a small but significant window to the West in the 17th and 18th centuries, introducing new artistic conventions and ideas. But it was the reopening of Japan to trade in the 1850s that brought quantities of Japanese prints and other artefacts into Europe, creating an explosion of interest in Japanese art and design among artists in the West, including the Impressionists and Post-Impressionists. In tracing these developments, from Namban to Japonaiserie, the collision of Japanese and Western visual traditions and techniques will be explored.

The lecture is free to members and visitors are most welcome for a fee of £8.





Pittville Park Sensory Garden Brief for Artwork

Six brick planters in the main children's play area, next to the aviaries, in Pittville Park have recently been cleared of overgrown shrubs which were rather uninteresting. The play area is probably the most popular in Gloucestershire for children up to 12 years old and the aviaries contain a variety of birds and rabbits for younger children and their families.

Friends of Pittville (FOP) are working on a scheme to turn the beds into a sensory garden with appropriate planting and signage but at the same time make them fun and interesting for children. Each bed will be planted to represent one of the senses. FOP would like to include artwork/signage, which could either take the form of five smaller individual artworks/sculptures related to the sense within each bed or a larger single item in one of the beds expressing all of the senses.
