610.021. Except to the extent disclosure is otherwise required by law; a public governmental body is authorized to close meetings, records and votes, to the extent they relate to the following:
(3) Hiring, firing, disciplining or promoting of particular employees by a public governmental body when personal information about the employee is discussed or recorded. However, any votes on a final decision, when taken by a public governmental body, to hire, fire, promote or discipline an employee of a public governmental body shall be made available with a record of how each member voted to the public within seventy-two hours of the close of the meeting where such action occurs; provided, however, that any employee so affected shall be entitled to prompt notice of such decision during the seventy-two-hour period before such decision is made available to the public. As used in this subdivision, the term "personal information" means information relating to the performance or merit of individual employees;
(13) Individually identifiable personnel records, performance ratings or records pertaining to employees or applicants for employment, except that this exemption shall not apply to the names, positions, salaries and lengths of service of officers and employees of public agencies once they are employed as such, and the names of private sources donating or contributing money to the salary of a chancellor or president at all public colleges and universities in the state of Missouri and the amount of money contributed by the source;

<u>Presentation of Treasurer's Report</u>: The report was presented to the board members. There were some questions about the CD's at Farmer's State Bank and Nodaway Valley Bank and the interest rate that is being paid. The question was if the CD's were redeemed and placed into an investment company would the banks waive the penalty. Nodaway Valley bank would waive the penalty, Farmer's State Bank would not. Walk and Florea discussed the options and what the possible outcome would be. It was left to Walk to make the necessary changes that may be needed, and he will report back to the board.

Item three was to inform the board members that the Rescue Air Bags have been ordered for the units 140 and 142, for the cost of \$8,754.98.

Item four was to inform the board members that Brittney Drummond was released from probation.

Item five was inform the board members that ten new EMR were added to the Burlington Junction squad.

Item six was to inform the board members that he had to purchase five new pagers for the new EMR staff.

Item seven was to inform the board members that unit 131 is on loan to Andrew County Ambulance. They had two of their ambulances break down.

Item eight was to inform the board members that the MCRS will be at the Nodaway County fair for relief and if any medical service is needed.

Business Manager's Report: Item one was to inform the board members that the accounts receivable is still off, but it is now \$210.61.

Item two was to inform the board the 2017 audit is to start on July 12th.

Item three was to inform the board members that her surgery is scheduled for August 27th. Her surgeon would like a 4-6-week recovery period but has agreed to let Lager decide when she can tolerate coming back to the office to work.

<u>Training Managers Report:</u> Item one was to inform the board members that quarterly CPR class had nine individuals Item two has been discussed, the new EMR responders.

The crew needed extra personnel and they were late in arriving due to lack of page. There was a discussion about the money that the ambulance district pays for dispatching, and the quality of dispatching. There was no outcome of the discussion, Florea is to talk with the Sheriff to see if anything can be done about this type of situation.
