

ORDINANCE NUMBER 53 OF THE CITY OF EUBANKS, KENTUCKY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EUBANKS, KENTUCKY:

That, whereas, the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Kentucky has passed KRS 83A.020, effective July 15, 1980, which declares that each city presently organized and governed under the provisions of KRS Chapter 88 is declared to be organized and governed under the commission plan of government, and, whereas, the City of Eubanks, Kentucky, being a city of the sixth class, is governed by the provisions of KRS Chapter 88, and, whereas, KRS 83A.030 provides that each city organized and governed under the commission plan shall have a legislative body composed of a mayor and four (4) city commissioners, and, whereas, said statute further provides that, before the expiration of the terms of the present legislative body, the members thereof shall take necessary action to be in compliance with this section,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EUBANKS, KENTUCKY, that the office of Board of Trustees, consisting of five (5) members, be, and the same hereby is, declared abolished effective with the end of the terms of the present members of the Board of Trustees on midnight of the first Sunday in January, 1982.
