

Rev. Bruce E. Malcom, Pastor Provídence Baptist Church

Rev. Malcom began his spiritual journey at Southern Baptist Church in 1976. He was set aside as a deacon under the leadership of Pastor James E. Milton in 1996. Rev. Malcom humbly served as a deacon until he received his calling to the preaching ministry in 2004. In 2007 he was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel under the leadership of Pastor C.
