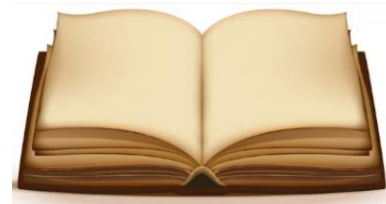

BIBLE INSIGHT:

WHY DO WE SAY THAT JESUS LEFT THE EUCHARIST?

Some protestant bible scholars say that Jesus was speaking in analogy when Jesus said that he was the bread of life, and that He gave us his body to eat and his blood to drink. They say that He was speaking symbolically. Protestants say that Jesus' intention was not to stay in the eucharist.

It is true that Jesus says some analogies relate with his mission, for example He says: "I am the way, the truth and the life; He said that He is the door; also, He said that He is the good shepherd. However, that explanation that Jesus said about to be the bread of life it was different.

First of all: Jesus in different occasion He explained about the bread of life and to be eaten by the people. We can read it in Luke 22:19ss. Luke 24:13-35; Matthew 26:28ss; Mark 14:22; John 6:51ss. Acts 2:42-47; Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 11:17-33.

The explanation of Jesus about giving his body and his blood is abundant in the gospel. The INTENTION of Jesus was to be understood correctly.

Besides that, remember that Jesus gave the power to the eleven to continue to do his mission (Mt. 28:18-20). The disciples understood that Jesus asked them to continue to celebrate the Eucharist. Saint Paul writes: "For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night He was handed over, took bread, and after He had given thanks, broke it, and said, this is my body, that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me. In the same way also the cup.... For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until He comes again (1 Cor. 11:23-24).

Finally, the history of the Church, that starts in the Acts of the Apostles book help us to make sure to follow Jesus' intentions.
