As of January 1, 2022, contacting our Courtesy Officer, David Bonillas, will be much easier. Instead of a pager, you will now contact an answering service. David was having problems returning calls from the blocked number he was using. Since David is an active Shreveport Police Officer, he cannot give out his cell number. Also, when he returned calls, some people's phones would not allow them to receive a call from a blocked number. Since there was no way for David to know who the caller was or where they lived, he couldn't get in touch with them. With the help of King's Telemessaging Service, we came up with a better idea. As of January 1, 2022, if you need to reach David, you will dial **318-459-2103** and the answering service will get some information from you and contact David. He will either call you back as long as your phone will accept blocked numbers or he will come by your house as soon as he can. Please keep in mind that if it is an emergency, please call SPD at 673-7300, Option #3, or dial 911. Please put these phone numbers in a handy spot and also put them in your cell phone for quick reference.

Just a reminder, dues go up to \$166 per month starting January 1st. If you are on Auto Draft with our office, it has already been taken care of. If you have your bank pay your dues automatically, then you will need to notify them about the change. The Paypal button on our website has been changed to reflect the new amount.

We are still having issues with people not cleaning up after their dogs. There is absolutely NO excuse for this! We have 10 Pet Stations throughout the property that are serviced weekly. Not only does pet feces carry diseases that can make people very sick, it is unsightly and stinks. Also, if any dog is caught off leash, the owner will be fined. If the owner is not with the dog and we cannot locate the owner right away, the dog will go to Animal Control.
