WHAT IS MIGHTY-MIN®?

MIGHTY-MIN® is a liquid mineral supplement for livestock manufactured in the Ballarat country district of Australia by Westminster Pastoral Company (WPC) and distributed throughout Australia by TNN Australia.

MIGHTY-MIN[®] mineral supplements use quality organic stabilisation materials, some in the form of Lignosulphonates and Liquid Kelp, to achieve a safe and effective mineral supplement product that can last in the system of the animal for the longest possible time.

NATURE AT WORK FOR YOU

Severe deficiencies in horses are uncommon in Australia due to improvements in identification and treatment. However, marginal deficiencies are much more difficult to identify, and significant performance losses may occur without any obvious symptoms being present. Symptoms such as mild or intermittent lameness may be signs of a nutrient imbalance, rather than an outright deficiency.

Horses at greatest risk of nutrient deficiencies include high-level performance horses, pregnant and lactating mares, growing horses up to 2 years of age, and horses that are stalled 24/7 on an all-hay diet with no pasture access.

Fresh grass contains high levels of Vitamin E, but these drop once the grass is cut for hay and stored.

Horses on pasture get their Vitamin A from forage but, similar to Vitamin E, levels begin to decrease once the grass is cut for hay.

The equine digestive tract contains microbes which are responsible for digestion of food and production of B group vitamins. If the hindgut is too acidic, due to too much grain, colic or fevers, production of B group vitamins may be compromised, leading to poor skin health or muscle development and poor immune or nervous system function.

PRODUCT USAGE CONSIDERATIONS AND SAFETY

This preparation contains both Selenium and Copper, both capable of toxic effects. Recommended doses must be adhered to. DO NOT administer at the same time with other preparations that contain Selenium. DO NOT administer if grazing pasture contains plants known to have a high Copper content. Ensure animals have access to water. Avoid stress to young or weak animals. Check drenching gun for accuracy before and during use. Ensure drenching nozzle smoothness.
