Winter Wonderland


Sleigh bells ring, are you listening? In the lane, snow is glistening A beautiful sight we're happy tonight Walking in a winter wonderland

"Light the Kinara for Kwanzaa"

- Kwanzaa derives from the Swahili phrase matunda ya kwanza, meaning "first fruits".
- A kinara is a candelabra holding seven candles, each representing a day in the festival of Kwanzaa.
- A karamu feast is celebrated on Dec. 31 and a forum for cultural expression which includes food, dancing, music, readings. Takes place in homes and communities.
- Mazao are the fruits and vegetables of the harvest.
- Nguzo saba are the seven principals of African Heritage.
