Past Scholarship Awards

- HWWC provides \$500 and \$1000 scholarships to Traditional and Non-Traditional students attending College in Weld County.
- HWWC has given 2-3 scholarships to nontraditional students every year since 1999
- In 2021, HWWC expanded the scholarship program to include traditional and postsecondary degree students. 12 scholarships were awarded for a total of \$11,500.
- In 2022, HWWC adjusted the nontraditional scholarship awards to be renewable to support students throughout their academic careers. \$1000 renewable up to 4 times.
