## Lunch Program

For FY 2023-2024
Breakfast is $\$ 1.75$ per meal and Lunches are $\$ 3.50$. If you qualify free/reduced meals; either direct certified through the state or by filling out an application your meal will be free or at a reduced rate- breakfast is $\$ .30$ and lunch is $\$ .40$. Any extra servings, ie: apple or orange, are an additional cost.

A permission form is required for your child to purchase EXTRAS at an additional cost. Please read, sign and return it to the office. If the form is not returned your child will not be allowed to receive extra's or break milk when money is not available.

Brussels CUSD 42 appreciates your cooperation in keeping your accounts paid. If the account drops to -\$25 the school has the right to limit what your child is served. School policy has been set for a maximum of - $\$ 25$ balance per family. After reaching this negative balance services can be restricted by not allowing any extra's
