Looking back we've established that letters and names have meanings, let's look at what God hid in Genesis 5, the genealogy of man. These are the first 10 men mentioned in the Bible and Torah, (with the exclusion of Cain and Able), in order of birth. We have established the fact that Adam being the first was named and his name meant "man". Seth was born after Cain killed his brother Able, when Seth was born we are told that Eve said "God hath_appointed me another to replace Abel, Genesis 4:25, so it was that his name shall mean appointed. The hidden message is as you read down the list from top or first birth to the bottom, God placed their births in order to proclaim the future coming of the Lord Jesus thousands of years before He actually came born as a man. Man (is) appointed mortal sorrow, the blessed God shall come down, teaching his death shall bring, the despairing comfort, rest. What's interesting to note here is that when we look at Methuselah, we know based on research that he was the oldest man in the bible (at 969 years old), and the people of his time knew what his name meant, that upon his death shall bring the flood of Noah's day. Reviewing the Bible and Torah we see that the flood came in the same year as Methuselah's death. God pronounced His only son coming into the world and the reason for His birth, teaching and dying for us.
