## Notes from Hidden Manna part 3

The first step in the process was a logical one after I realized everything you have read about to this point, it was time to gather the data that would be used to find the verse or verses, remember, I did not know how many I was looking for or what I would find, I didn't even consider that right now because by faith I was plodding along feeling that it would be Him that would reveal what was to be found. This verse set me up for what I was about to set out on, it is;

#### Proverbs 25:2;

#### It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, but the glory of kings is to search out a matter.

The first step was to gather the book of Micah from Torah, the Bilbe Hub was a great resource. What you see next is the raw data collection, at first I started gathering every  $49^{th}$  letter from the first Tav like this  $\underline{\mathbf{n}}$ , I used the letter Tav with the dot in the middle producing the "T" sound, originally I didn't notice that there were 2 Tav's (1 producing an S (SAV) sound the other producing a T (TAV) sound). On the alphabet chart this one was noted as Tav, that was a blessing by Christ, I had a 50 50 shot at choosing the right one, I began finding enough quickly to know I was on the right track. Next because there will be those who want the raw data that was used to find the Hidden Manna, I've included all of that below. From the first Tav, I counted every  $7^{th}$  letter and turned that letter to red, every  $49^{th}$  letter is highlighted in yellow. I didn't know it at the time but the  $49^{th}$  letter by itself wasn't going to yield any fruit, every  $7^{th}$  letter would.

These Hebrew letters and text were pulled from the Bible Hub, an online Bible study site which in this case includes the Hebrew text from Torah. A big shout out of thanks to those folks.

# **Organization and secrets revealed**

# Getting Organized

I typed out some common words I thought I might find, to help me recognize words that I thought were important. I believed I'd recognize some words that would stand out and help in finding manna. It was a good thought, although I have trouble remembering why I walked into the kitchen when I thought about doing this just a monment before! So no, this really didn't play a part in the discovery still these words were in front of me everytime I was working for the solution and gave me hope to see them.

### "Searching for the words of the Lord"

changed frequently until I got my act together, I kept going back to discover changes in meanings of words or phrases and altering highlighted colors to increase or decrease the word or phrases significance to me, without placing the word or phrase in the lower bottom section marked.

### **Discoveries**

That happened further along the way to track my changes and see or remember what I had found before, this really helped to keep changes identified, or what I thought might be a significant find. This section, is where I began to color code as noted above. There were many changes made over the course of many months in searching for this secret word of Christ. When I finally got my act together, and organized my findings in a way that I could keep my thoughts and the Lords words in a logical search sequence, my eyes were opened to see! As the word really began to develop I was constantly struck how everything began to flow together, most certainly because of the way the text was derived, from every 7<sup>th</sup> letter from the original text, wow, what an awesome savior we have.

### Please note that the last line with green highlighting, of the *Hebrew text*

(In the section marked - *Searching for the words of the Lord*)

Is the complete secret revealed in its true <u>hidden manna</u> form **within the Hebrew text** of every 7<sup>th</sup> letter from the first tav, of the Hebrew book of Micah, this text is highlighted in green found in its discovered position within the text of the chapter.

A much more organized view and the real work begins! The final discovered hidden manna is the last line highlighted in green. Each individual line are the working letters that had to be gleened from the orginal text of Micah. In each chapter generally the line is repaeated so that I could continue working and looking for the hidden verse and not disgraud things which I already found and might want to look back at again. Discovery is a long learning process, although very rewarding. The color codeing really helped me to focus on results. I knew that the verses would have to make logical sense, it had to be in context all the way through, I asked the Lord this along the way and He clearly answered with "It is". In other words I believed that it couldn't read something like this; Steve takes the trash out on Monday, cats are fun, blue is a color. What I was looking to find would have to have similar context making sense along the entire verse. For each chapter the format will be the same from here on out, starting out with the raw data line all of the 7<sup>th</sup> letters as found, basis for discovery. Then in the section searching for the words of the

<u>Lord</u>, each successive line is the raw data line where the search started to take place, not changing letter positions just spacing looking for words and phrases, each line is the same but I would find something of interest and rather than losing site of that by changing what I saw for something new, I just copied the line below and started moving the letters again so I didn't move or forget what I had already found before. I might want to come back to that if something I found further along would match up with that, this was an important move for me, I often went back to see other things already discovered. For instance below in chapter 1 there are 11 lines for discovery, all are the same except for moving the spacing, I was hunting, lots of trial and error along the way. In some lines you'll note the Tav has disappeared, not sure why those didn't copy over but I just kept going, that wasn't needed at this point for discovery.
