## Committee Member – Election Process



In line with the CNWA constitution, the following guidelines for the election of Committee Members have been agreed by the current CNWA committee.

### Nomination

Any CNWA coordinator member is eligible to self-nominate for a CNWA committee position. Only Scheme Coordinators are eligible to stand for election.

Nominations must be accompanied by two references from either a current scheme member, or a colleague from an organisation you have been involved with, or from an organisation you have worked for.

Nominations with supporting reference forms must be submitted by **midnight Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2020** to: Secretary, CNWA, c/o Corporate Communications, Cheshire HQ, Clemonds Hey, Oakmere Road, Winsford, Cheshire CW7 2UA Email: [cheshireneighbourhoodwatch@outlook.com](mailto:cheshireneighbourhoodwatch@outlook.com).

### Voting Process

The voting membership shall consist of any registered Neighbourhood Watch Coordinator.

A list of Standing Nominees and a link to the electronic ballot paper will be sent to Coordinators on **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2020**.

Voting will take place between **9.30am Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> November** and **midnight Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2020**.

Following the ballot count, candidates will be contacted to advise them of the results.

The results will be announced to the membership at the AGM on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2020**.

Cheshire Police Watch Special Point of Contact will act as the independent adjudicator.
