These are the categories of courses. Once you click on a topic, you can browse more specific courses.




Things to keep in mind about Gale Courses

- 1) There are specific start dates for these courses, that you can choose when to start.
 - a) I.e. I'm taking a sign language course, and my start dates could be: Oct. 18th, Nov. 15, Dec. 13, or Jan 17.
- 2) Each course have 12 lessons, and each lesson is released at different times throughout the course. And the lessons are asynchronous (meaning you can take the lessons at your own pace).
 - I.e. I chose Oct. 18th as my start date. My course has 12 lessons, and only 2 lessons will be released per week.
- 3) There is an instructor behind each of these courses in case you have questions.
- 4) No penalty for not completing courses!

Peterson's Test and Career Prep

- -This is a brand new resource we added to our collection at the beginning of 2024.
- -This site allows you to search for thousands of college and graduate schools, identify scholarships, take practice vocational/standardized tests, create resumes, and explore careers.
- -You'll need to sign up for an account to fully access.
- ***Please Note: there is a LOT this resource can help you with. I'll only be covering a small portion, but it is worth exploring on your own.***
