The Canal Society also operates the Port Byron Old Erie Canal Heritage Park, located on the New York State Thruway at Port Byron, NY. The goal of the Park is to inform and educate travelers about the history of canals and to make them aware of other canal related parks within the state.

Members of the Canal Society receive the scholarly publication, *Bottoming Out*, twice a year. This journal contains interesting facts relating to the canals of the State, as well as details of events and trips. Members also receive first notifications of all the Society's trips and events, such as the Winter Symposium, Field Trips, and Canal Conferences.
