Crew B transported the winner of the 'Ride to School on a Fire Truck' at the Spring Bluff School Auction.

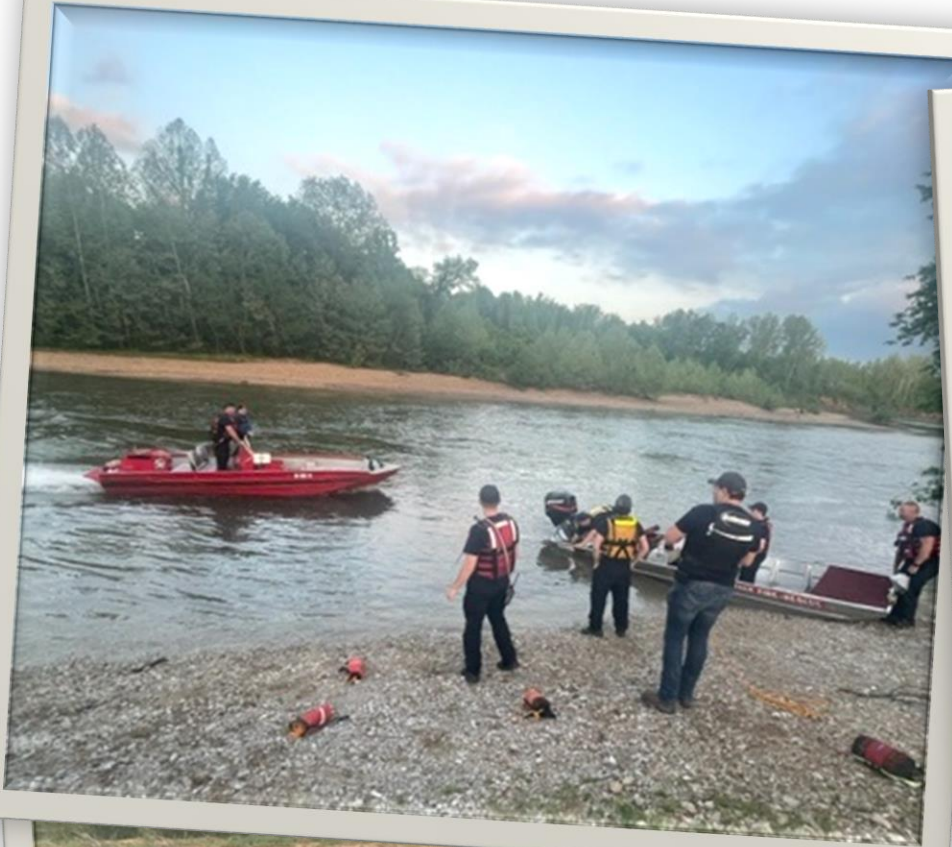

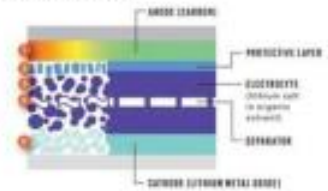

Thermal Runaway in a Lithium-ion Battery

1. Heating starts.
2. Protective layer breaks down.
3. Electrolyte breaks down into flammable gases.
4. Separator melts, possibly causing a short circuit.
5. Cathode breaks down, generating oxygen.

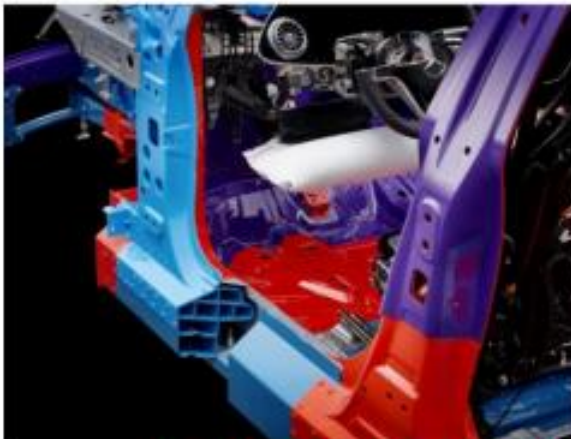
