NFIRSGRAM

Corrugated Stainless Steel Tubing (CSST) has gained national attention for its presence in fatal fires, with the cause of the fire oftentimes correlated to lightning strikes. Proper capture of the existence of CSST and causal factors is essential in fully understanding the problem. Accurate capture of fire causal information, of all types, will make communities safer and help to protect the lives of the firefighters and other first responders.

In the United States, approximately 500,000 new homes per year have CSST installed in them — approximately half of the number of new homes built each year that use gas for heating and cooking. As of 2012, an estimated seven million homes in the U.S. had CSST installed. Since 1989, approximately one billion feet have been installed in residential, commercial, and industrial structures.

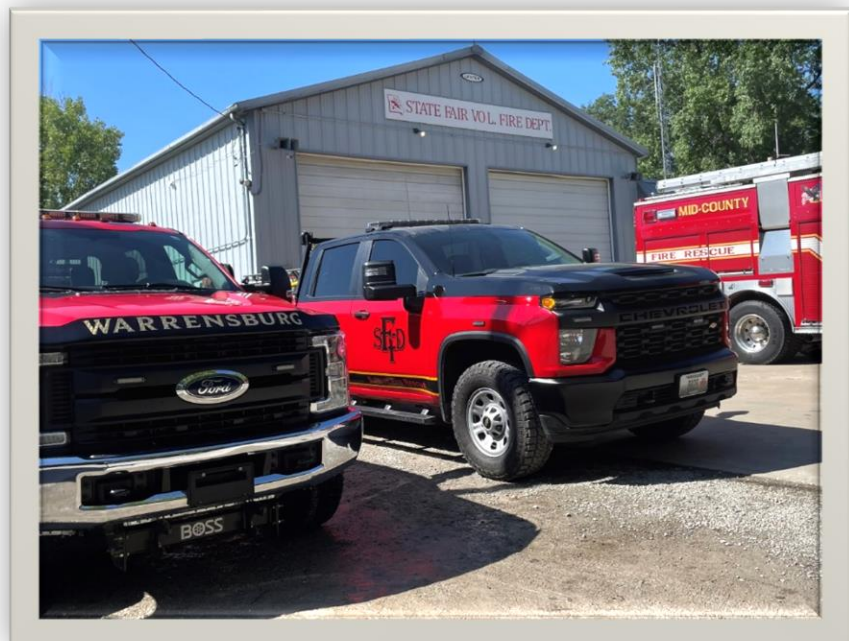
From the Desk of Captain Konys

Just a quick training minute about drafting from the two new Brush Trucks. Each truck is equipped with a 15' suction line and a hand primer. These are great assets that allow us to use the truck to suction water from a rural water source and fill our tanks or a small water supply. If you have any questions, feel free to contact us.

Steps to drafting:

- 1.) Unscrew the 2.5"-1.5" fill reducer and attach the suction/draft hose.
- 2.) Place Suction/Draft Hose into the static water source.
- 3.) Place the Tank to Pump Valve in the closed position.
- 4.) Place the tank fill valve in the open position.
- 5.) Place the priming valve to the open position.
- 6.) Use the hand primer and prime the pump. This can take up to 30 pumps of the valve. (listen for the change of tone in the pump to know when you have pulled a draft)
- 7.) Open the pump recirculating valve to fill the tank or a discharge valve to use the Discharge.
- 8.) Once full, close the tank fill/suction valve.
- 9.) Open tank to pump to switch to tank water.
