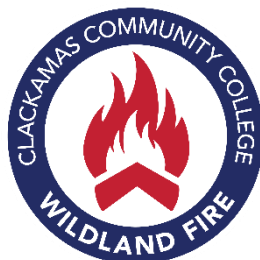


Course Description
