S-212 Wildland Fire Chain Saws

April 12 to 15, 2018

This is 4 day class. 1.5 days of classroom, 2.5 days of cutting out in the field. This class will prepare students for the certification process.

The lead instructor, Jeff Pricher is a former USFS employee with working experience in Engines, Hand crews and Helicopter rappelling. He has been working in the federal system for 20 years and has fought fire in several states across the western and central US. His passions include teaching the lost art of timber felling and firing operations with respect to the safety, operational needs of the job tasks and fundamentals of project planning when requested to operate in the wildland environment. Current red card qualifications include EMPF, FIRB, FALC, TFLD, STEN, DIVS and ICT3. Jeff is a team member and Division Supervisor on a federal Type II Incident Management Team (IMT) and federal Type I IMT. Outside of wildland, Jeff is a division chief who manages the special operations program (Rope Rescue, Swiftwater Rescue, Marine operations and SUAS) for two fire districts as well as serving as a duty officer and fire marshal.

Students will need to bring: 1 Chainsaw, Chaps, Leather gloves, hearing protection, eye protection, long sleeved shirt, srench, and fuel / bar oil containers for the equipment, preferably a dolmar. This is a 4 day class with 1.5 days of classroom and 2.5 days of cutting out in the field. **This class will not certify students, but will prepare them for the certification process.**
