The lead instructor, Jeff Pricher is a former USFS employee with working experience in Engines, Hand crews and Helicopter rappelling. He has been working in the federal system for 20 years and has fought fire in several states across the western and central US. His passions include teaching the lost art of timber felling and firing operations with respect to the safety, operational needs of the job tasks and fundamentals of project planning when requested to operate in the wildland environment. Current red card qualifications include EMPF, FIRB, FALC, TFLD, STEN, DIVS and ICT3. Jeff is a team member and Division Supervisor on a federal Type II Incident Management Team (IMT) and federal Type I IMT. Outside of wildland, Jeff is a division chief who manages the special operations program (Rope Rescue, Swiftwater Rescue, Marine operations and sUAS) for two fire districts as well as serving as a duty officer and fire marshal.
