THE CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct will require workers and providers delivering supports and services to do the following in providing those supports and services:

- 1. Act with respect for individual rights to freedom of expression, selfdetermination and decision-making in accordance with applicable laws and conventions.
- 2. Respect the privacy of people with disability.
- 3. Provide supports and services in a safe and competent manner with care and skill.
- 4. Act with integrity, honesty and transparency.
- 5. Promptly take steps to raise and act on concerns about matters that may impact the quality and safety of supports and services provided to people with disability.
- Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to all forms of violence against, and exploitation, neglect and abuse of, people with disability.
- 7. Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to sexual misconduct.
