- Chapters should send at least **one representative (Chapter President or Treasurer)** to the registration area with attendee IDs to check in and pick up badges for all preregistered and pre-paid attendees.

- Acceptable forms of payment are debit/ credit card, cashier's checks and organizational/university checks (organizational check is one with a company name on it). Personal checks and cash are **NOT** accepted onsite!
