Our chapter offers Mandarin language classes with Mrs. Margaret Huang, Certified Mandarin Teacher: Intro and Proficiency levels to K-12<sup>th</sup> Grade members of our NSBE, Jr. Chapter. Students will learn Mandarin Chinese language and culture through traditional lessons as well as songs, stories, games, and art projects in a student-centered environment. Cultural elements are woven into the curriculum so that students can study the Chinese language while also learning about Chinese culture and life.
