- b) Open members shall not allow the use of their boats on association lake waters or vehicle on Association property by non-members, and must accompany guests when using the beach, picnic or campground areas.

GEMNERAL RULES

- 5. PERMISSIVE USE-The Goose Lake Association does not assume liability for accidents to persons using its recreational facilities (includes beach, campground, marinas, parks, lakes, andother Goose Lake Association property).
- a)Property owners shall notallow the use of their watercraft on Association lake waters or vehicles on Association property by non-members unless they accompany them or are present on their property on such occasions. Property owners must accompany guests when using the beach, picnic or campground areas.
- b) Property owners shall not allow any non-members access to GLAlake waters (frozen or not) or GLA property with any watercraft or motorized vehicle that does not have a current GLA decal.
- c)Open members shall not allow the use of their boats on association lake waters or vehicle on Association property by non-members, and must accompany guests when using the beach, picnic or campground areas
