Motion passed. Storage

area cleaned up , large branch removed spoke of Cotton tree removal and that we are required to have a Dam inspection report.

Safety- Jim Grady spoke of safety issues on the lakes and how tickets are going to be given out for kids under 13 not wearing life jackets. A lengthy discussion on wake was addressed, speed vs. boat size, what is the actual definition of wake, maybe a detailed description needs to go out to the community.

Shoreline- Everything going good.

Fish- Suppliers are going out of business, checking with Ceco to see where they purchase from. Might be a problem in the future.

Boats- Measure before you buy. Dave Barker discussed the amount of water craft on our lakes.
