Dave Bogash made a motion seconded by Marie Stover to adjourn the meeting at 9:01 pm Meeting adjourned.



#### **SECTION 6.5: WATERCRAFT OPERATION RULES**

Current:

(c) No boat shall pull more than two (2) skiers or tubes at one time. The operator of any watercraft that is towing a person or persons shall display on the watercraft a bright or brilliant orange flag measuring not less than 12 inches per side. The flag shall be displayed at the highest point of the area surrounding the boat's helm as to be visible from all directions, continuously while the person or persons being towed depart the boat in preparation for towing and until reentry into the boat when the activity has ceased. Display of the flag for purposes other than the activity described in this Section is prohibited.

Propose:

(c) No boat shall pull more than two (2) skiers or tubes at one time EXCEPT FOR PONTOONS, SEE SECTION 6.2 (f). NO BOAT SHALL PULL ANYONE WITH A SHORTER TOW ROPE THAN 25' FROM THE REAR OF THE BOAT. The operator of any watercraft that is towing a person or persons shall display on the watercraft a bright or brilliant orange flag measuring not less than 12 inches per side. The flag shall be displayed at the highest point of the area surrounding the boat's helm as to be visible from all directions, continuously while the person or persons being towed depart the boat in preparation for towing and until reentry into the boat when the activity has ceased. Display of the flag for purposes other than the activity described in this Section is prohibited.
