(b) The max number of Jet Skis, also known as Personal Watercraft (PWC's), decals issued by the association is 100 per season. GLA will reserve decals for renewals from the previous year until April 1st of the current year. If the decals are not renewed by April 1st, the decals will be issued to property owners on the waiting list on a first-come/first served basis.

TO: SECTION 6.6

(b) The max number of decals for Personal Watercraft that will be issued by the GLA in a given year will be 120 and will be applied as follows:

1. Jet Skis – No more than 100 PWC decals will be active at any given time during each year for jetski use. GLA will reserve decals for renewal from the previous year until April 1st of the current year. If the decals are not renewed by April 1st, the decals will be issued to property owners from the waiting list on a first come – first served basis.

2. eFoils – No more than 20 PWC decals will be active at any given time during each year for eFoil use. GLA will reserve decals for renewal from the previous year until April 1st of the current year. If the decals are not renewed by April 1st, the decals will be issued to property owners from the waiting list on a first come – first served basis.
