Kyle Oaks discussed letting the lil Coalers wrestling club using our facility for practice. How many kids was addressed and what equipment they use. Cleanliness was addressed and a plan if someone test positive to Covid.

Terry expressed his concerns. Who from GLA is the go to person and/or to supervise.

Kyle made a motion seconded by Mike Poeschel regarding Lil Coalers wrestling club (see attached motion # 48) Motion Passed.

Dave Barker discussed the wording of watercraft and jet ski, he also has asked for help and suggestions from the entire board with no result. He read some suggestions from home owners. 
Motion by Mike Poeschel seconded by Phil Sheedy to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried meeting adjourned at 10:15 pm
