RESOLUTION NO. 2023-15
2023 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

To authorize the filing of an application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs, Community Development Block Grant Program for Small City Competitive funds; to commit a local match for the project; and to authorize the Mayor of Brundidge to sign all documents related to the filing of PY 2023 CDBG Application.

WHEREAS, the Alabama Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program has been established to assist local governments in meeting community development and housing needs consistent with the objectives set forth in Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brundidge, acting by and through the City Council proposes to apply for Community Development Block Grant funds to make critical improvements at the Wastewater Treatment Facility and to improve sewer mains on Nassau, Pine and Lawson streets; and

WHEREAS, under terms and provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, the City of Brundidge as a recipient of these funds is required to designate and appoint a Financial Officer to perform certain duties in the administration of said grant.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Brundidge, as follows:

THAT, Isabell Boyd, Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs, requesting Program Year 2023 CDBG funds in the amount of \$400,000; and

THAT, the City of Brundidge hereby commits to provide cash resources to complete the project in the amount of \$641,300 for the local share of the project; and

THAT, Isabell Boyd, or the current Mayor, be and is hereby designated and appointed as Financial Officer under the terms and pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and is directed and empowered to make necessary assurances and to perform on behalf of the City of Brundidge, those acts and assume such duties as are consistent with said position.
