In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus explains the meaning of the scriptures. Like the disciples, when we offer and receive forgiveness our hearts burn because we encounter the risen Christ within us. Have you considered answering the call to "help the poor find forgiveness and healing in their life" by joining the Society of St. Vincent de Paul?



Dear St. Pan Fam,

In the Gospel for today, Jesus appears once again to his disciples. He senses their skepticism by the questions that arise in their hearts. I shared in my homily last week how it is easy to interpret this skepticism as a result of weak faith. There are some scholars who believe that their desire for irrefutable evidence of the Resurrection was necessary. It allowed for the Apostles to become true eyewitnesses. By first being skeptical, and later coming to believe, their testimony carried more weight.

Similarly to last week, Jesus greets the apostles by saying, "Peace be with you." The peace that Jesus wishes to share is an interior peace, such as peace in the heart. This type of heartfelt peace is only found when it is rooted in Christ. We can often times confuse peace with comfort. True interior peace is found when we are living as we are meant to be. We were created for relationship with God and can only achieve peace while living out this relationship.

Jesus gives us the first steps of how we can be rooted in relationship with God as he reminds us of why he came in the first place: for repentance and forgiveness of sins. Forgiveness awaits only those who repent. In order to proclaim the good news of our salvation, it must be accompanied with the call to repentance. Jesus tells the disciples that they are witnesses to this. He too invites us to be witnesses.

Querida Familia de San Pancraccio,

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús se aparece una vez más a sus discípulos. Él percibe su escepticismo por las preguntas que surgen en sus corazones. Compartí en mi homilía de la semana pasada cómo es fácil interpretar este escepticismo como resultado de una fe débil. Hay algunos eruditos que creen que su deseo de evidencia irrefutable de la Resurrección era necesaria. Permitted que los Apóstoles se convirtieran en verdaderos testigos oculares. Al ser escépticos primero, y luego llegar a creer, su testimonio tuvo más peso.

De manera similar a la semana pasada, Jesús saluda a los apóstoles diciendo: "La paz sea con ustedes". La paz que Jesús quiere compartir es una paz interior, como la paz en el corazón. Este tipo de paz sincera solo se encuentra cuando está arraigada en Cristo. A menudo podemos confundir la paz con la comodidad. La verdadera paz interior se encuentra cuando estamos viviendo como estamos destinados a ser. Fuimos creados para la relación con Dios y solo podemos lograr la paz mientras vivimos esta relación.

Jesús nos da los primeros pasos de cómo podemos enraizarnos en la relación con Dios mientras nos recuerda por qué Él vino en primer lugar: Para el arrepentimiento y el perdón de los pecados. El perdón solo es para aquellos que se arrepienten. Para proclamar la buena nueva de nuestra salvación, debe ir acompañada de la llamada al arrepentimiento. Jesús les dice a los discípulos que son testigos de esto. Él también nos invita a ser testigos.

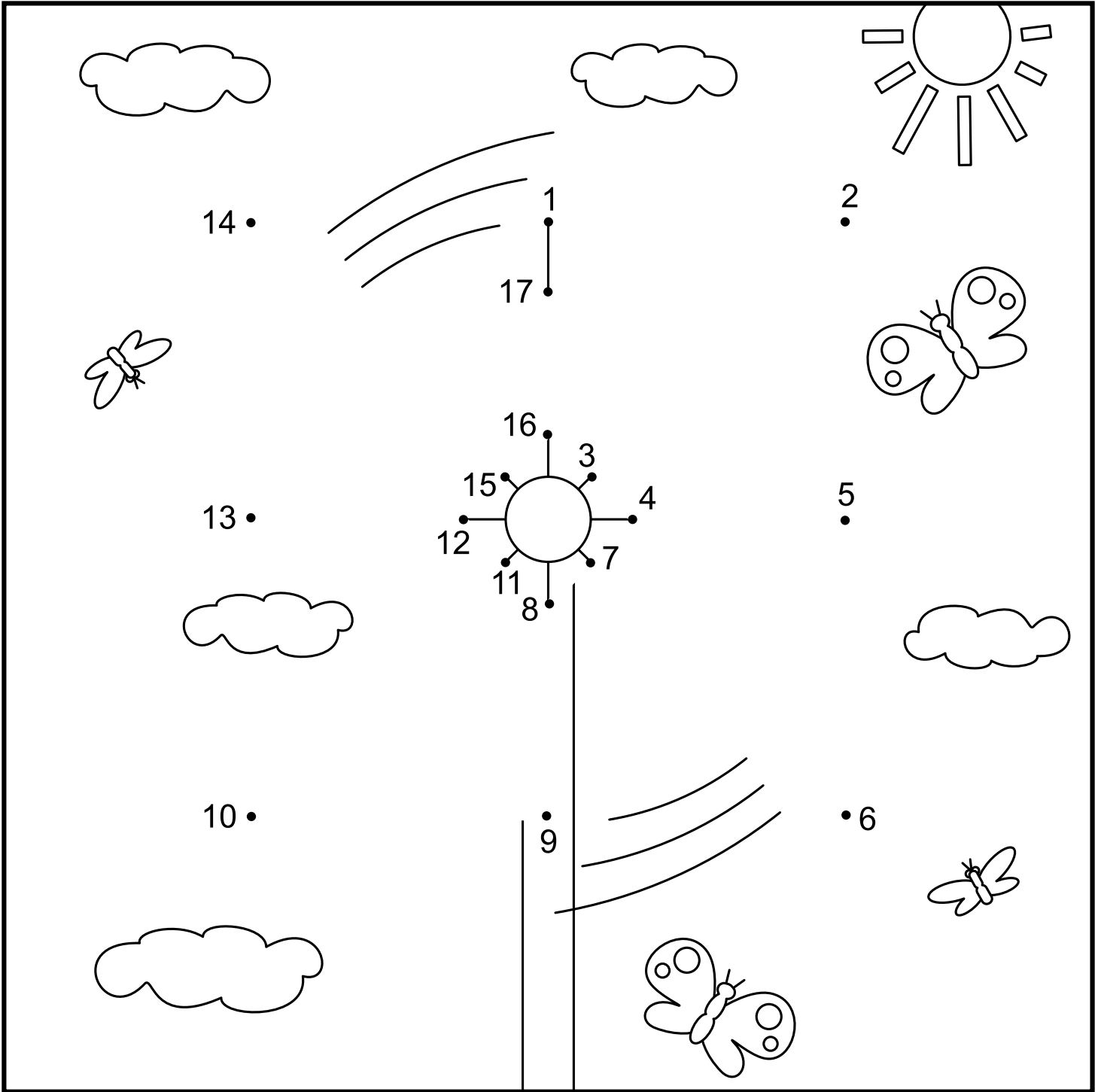
El fin de semana del 28 de abril de 2024,
