



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

Enriching Community Through the Arts

The Center for the Arts (CFA) is proud to offer student scholarships that support **the literary, performing, and visual arts** in the next generation. These scholarships are generously funded by our community.

Last year the CFA presented \$10,000 in scholarships to 9 students in grades 7-12 who are attending summer art programs or pursuing their artistic field in college. That said, the CFA has given almost \$50k in awards to 69 students in the past 8 years.



General Requirements for All Applicants

Applying students must:

- Reside in one of the 12 towns in the Lake Sunapee Region: Andover, Bradford, Danbury, Grantham, New London, Newbury, Newport, Springfield, Sunapee, Sutton, Warner, or Wilmot
- Be enrolled in public or private school, or home schooled.
- Submit a completed application for a scholarship which will help pay for arts-based classes or workshops or any other need related to their particular talent or college programs.
- Agree to share with the community a demonstration of their talent that is related to the scholarship.

By submitting your application, you agree, if awarded a CFA scholarship, to share your talent/work at a Center for the Arts event, with other scholarship winners, later this year.

Applications will not be considered unless complete.

The Lang Memorial Scholarship for high school seniors pursuing the literary, performing, or visual arts. The Madge Rizza Scholarship is awarded to high-school seniors pursuing the performing arts. The Hunting Scholarship is awarded to students pursuing the visual arts.

For Arts Program Applications Grades 7-11 and Graduating Seniors Pursuing Arts Education

Applications for arts related programs such as camps or other arts opportunities accepted.

- Deadline for the **application is May 15**
- Applicants who have not received a CFA scholarship in the past will be given priority
- All applications must be reviewed and applicants interviewed by the scholarship committee.
- Applications can be completed online or sent by mail.

Scholarship Application

Deadline May 15th for All levels

The CFA offers two types of scholarships.

- 1** For **students grades 7-11** interested in arts opportunities that enhance their skills such as art camp or art experiences.

Please submit your application and attach all four of the following documents:

Applications will not be accepted/considered unless ALL documents are attached or included

1. Current school, grade, name of program, location, and program cost
2. A one page essay, explaining your artistic talent, how you will use the scholarship, and how this experience will enhance your talent.
3. A sample or evidence of your artistic talent. (Sample work/programs from recitals, plays concerts, visual images or photos of art, etc., up to 6 images.)
4. A letter of recommendation from a teacher of your talent.

- 2** For **graduating high-school seniors** who are pursuing art related college, universities, or post-graduate arts opportunities.

Please Submit your application and attach all four of the following documents:

Applications will not be accepted/considered unless ALL documents are attached.

1. Current school, name of college and proof of admission.
2. An essay (1-2 pages) explaining your artistic talent and why you selected this college/university/program. Describe your long-term goals as you pursue your education and develop your artistic talents.
3. A sample or evidence of your artistic talent (Sample of work/programs from recitals, plays concerts, visual images or photos of art, etc., up to 6 images.)
4. Two letters of recommendation: One from an academic teacher, and one from a teacher of your talents.

By submitting your application, you agree, if awarded a CFA scholarship, to share your talent/work at a Center for the Arts event, with other scholarship winners, later this year.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
