• What's New Around the Lake

- Fishing rules have changed this year cockleburs is 10" and was 15" due to an experiment by the DEC to see if they can get bigger fish out of the lake as there are too many smaller fish. Sunfish which includes BlueGills 8" minimum with a limit. Look into to avoid breaking new regulations information is available on DEC website. It is a special regulation applicable to Silver Lake
- New sign stating swimming is prohibited at the public beach
- the Village was forced to put the sign in place but it will not be enforced it was a liability issue for the village so it is there but will not be enforced

• Grabby Bill's Docks - Docking and Mooring Laws

- DEC issued in 2017 a 400' permit for Mac's but it is unknown if that carries over to new owners
- 200' maximum extension for businesses and campsites is going to be proposed. Individual limits are 40'

- No new dredging information from April report
- No new information on Walker Rd Bridge allegedly funds are in place and ready to be replaced this year but no one knows
- Silver Lake Experience 8/4-8/7 August 4th 10 am Todd Shuskey (biology teacher at Perry HS) giving a lecture with his students
- Water Craft inspection steward Fri-Mon Memorial Day through Labor Day it is the 4th year in a row SL has had a boat steward
- about 8000 boats passed through last year and were inspected by boat steward
- Sewer system Joe Gozowski sewer system and pumping stations and ensuring integrity of these during power outage
- some discussions of generators but these are on people's properties

- Working on planting site and adding signage around the lake for boat launch and lake to show where the

 to distribute it because it is going right into tributaries. It will be performed by A-Tip

- Has been doing experiments with core samples about 3-4" in diameter and a few feet long



- samples are sent to UB so they are looking at it to measure lead, carbon, different plant species, etc.

 has retired and they moved away from the lake area. Could use 1-2 more seasons of diving if we could
 find help
- in particular at Camp Asbury there is lots to clean up and this is where the triathlon goes from
