• What's New Around the Lake - these were NOT put up for discussion with no questions or answers provided at the meeting and no opportunity for spectator input

- <u>Crabby Bill's Docks</u> Michelle Hess said Crabby Bill's extended docks another 100'. No permits were obtained to do this and the County is looking into this to see if a permit was needed or if they are violating any laws
- <u>Totes</u> flyers are available on the table at the front with schedules and instructions for the garbage program through the county. These were not distributed with the totes originally.



- What we know now about totes: everyone in Castile town is paying in their taxes trash pickup seasonal or full-year. Perry was not included in this. Eberstein, Prentice, and where Ron and Karen are was not included. If they are not included why can't others opt out? Because Town of Castile bought into it but Town of Perry did not.
- Jim Bragg WANTED to attend meeting. He was denied the opportunity to speak at this meeting. Regional Manager for WM has been contacted but it is not well understood on their end. WM contacted county without resolution. Becky Ryan was contacted the Chairwoman of Board of Supervisors. She was unable to reach resolution
- Assemblyman Dipietro's office was contacted to see if he could assist. No resolution at this time.

• Federal Street Gate

- Read in the Perry Herald that the Federal St Gate has a problem again. Rick Hauser deferred to Deputy Mayor Samantha. Mtg with her we learned they are losing 4 cu ft per second and the soonest it will be fixed is 4 weeks minimum to get permits. They want to put coffer dam at Walker Bridge to do their work and then allow back fill when it is fixed.

- Silver Lake Boat Steward (Janelle Hinkovich) to start Friday 5/27 and she will work every weekend Friday through Sunday 8:00 am to 6:00 PM each weekend
- Frank is working on letter to municipalities for upkeep plans for infrastrcture for sewer system
- Wegman's has agreed to donate 1\$ from every LED flare sale from Geneseo Wegman's
- Planting sessions 5th planting has occurred near Ro's sister's house last fall and everything is coming up very nicely
- currently looking for site this year and soil and water are assisting
- Working on two signs/posters to go up on state park and village beach to educate the public on the locations of plantings and the work of CLEAN at Silver Lake state has given permission waiting on town/village approval
- Japanese Knotweed invasive plant has four sites around the lake where it has taken hold we have someone ready to eradicate it. It has to be sprayed and requires a permit for removal. Requires two sprayings.
 - Soil and water gave good financial support to get it done and landowners are supportive as well
 - Hope is to take care of these four sites this year
- Golf tournament is July 30th committee is in place to help Joe and Ro
 - Joe and Frank are main organizers
 - Ron is helping with golf, Frank with sponsors, Joe doing finances, DJ Starner with registration, Bob Capurso on advertising, Karen and Bonnie Bright doing basket raffles and Lee Loomis with course water and food
