- Plaques housed at Marina down a hallway and out of sight can't be moved due to needed signage for their sales materials
- Will try to find a place around town (Charcoal Corral, Country Club, etc.) with more foot traffic to display the signage

Water Quality – Kelly Paganelli

- Frank in Alaska fishing – Kelly reports still working with Wyo Co Soil and Water for permission to do a fall planting
- Wyo Co is short staffed and we can't get approval so a fall planting might not happen
- Waste Water treatment facility tour happened with multiple members of CLEAN, SLA, and representative from City of Buffalo
- All in all everyone was pleased with the plan for the facility and the current status of the systems
- Are some areas where residents may be abusing system (flushing wipes, dumping grease into drains, mop heads, etc.) they are going to try to address
- Leaf disposal article in Perry Herald
- Temperature array is back and working
- Appreciate Joe for all he did for CLEAN – website, treasurer, golf tournament, 501C3 status
- Ron Norton says mopheads and towels into sewer they have been able to pinpoint that into the Asbury area of the lake



- Have begun landscaping the bridge on Walker Rd for replacement in springtime

- Perry can drop leaf debris off at dump site for Town of Perry
- 30% assessment rates had significant impact for school taxes
