This results in **non-combustible**, **stone panels or clusters**, which are up to 40% lighter weight than many of the other common man-made stone products, and up to 75% lighter than real stone veneers. This saves on freight, labour and, in some cases, mitigates the need for extra structural reinforcements when a fireplace is added during a renovation.

Durable – Long Lasting Finish: These nano-porous spheres are "moisture breathable" but do not absorb water. This unique set of properties makes our FeatherStone hydrophobic since it won't absorb large amounts of water, they will last longer than Perlite or pumice-based products in areas where freeze-thaw cycles can result in micro-cracks and eventual degradation of these other products over time.
