Online (Live) Math Instructional Sessions (Levels 1-6) & Online Private English Sessions (Levels 5-7)

Online Instructional Math Sessions:

All Levels 1-6 are provided with instructional videos included on the Google Classroom. Every week, students are required to watch a video, and complete the NOTES section along with the video, *before* attending their regular weekly classes with their teachers. As a substitute for these videos, there is another option called MATH INSTRUCTIONAL LIVE SESSIONS. These sessions are optional for students as the lesson taught within any given week is identical to the lesson taught on the provided video. Students who attend the live sessions will also be provided with the instructional video to use as a reference. **Those interested may sign up for this option separately.** These sessions will always meet ONLINE, but there will be an in-person option on Saturdays in South Riding. Students who attend these sessions will receive the instruction for the scheduled lesson *only*. Any homework questions or questions related to topics from another lesson must be reserved for the regularly weekly class. **The duration of the session will depend upon the length of the lesson. They will always start at the starting time, but may not last for the entire allotted time frame.**

Online Private English Meetings (for Levels 5 & 6):

Levels 5 & 6 English students will be assigned approximately one essay every month. Students will have the opportunity to meet privately with their English teachers for 20 minutes (online through ZOOM) to discuss their submitted rough or final drafts of their most recent essay. Student will be expected to take notes during the session, to take the teachers' suggestions, and to make the appropriate changes on their final drafts.

All meetings will be scheduled on the day of the week mentioned on this Academic Year Schedule; they will be held on a separate day/time than the regular week class. A sign-up sheet will be released to students via Google Classroom. Students will need to sign up ahead of time for their individual time slot.
