Commitments from staff and volunteers

- We will not use offensive language around young people and are aware that some language may be offensive to others even though we ourselves may not find it offensive.
- We will challenge young people who use offensive language and ask them not to do so.
- We will not smoke cigarettes around young people / families whilst representing Insight Community Project.
- We will not drink alcohol around young people / families whilst representing Insight Community Project and be aware of our actions in the wider community.
- We will use positive and encouraging language around young people and encourage them to do the same.
- We will attend sessions appropriately dressed.
- We will treat all service users with respect and follow equality and diversity policy.
- We will treat all other staff and volunteers with respect.
- We will encourage good relationships and sportsmanship between service users.
- We are aware of the disciplinary procedures of the organisation.

Commitments from service users and parents/ carers

- Will use appropriate and non-offensive language during sessions including before and after sessions.
- Will attend sessions appropriately dressed for activity taking place.
- Will be aware of how their actions can affect others and be mindful of this before, during and after sessions.
- Will not drink alcohol before or during a session.
- Will not smoke cigarettes during a session.
- Will not take illegal substances before or during a session.
- Are aware of the disciplinary procedure (detailed in disciplinary policy)
- Will follow health and safety guidelines set out by leaders. Including general safety and that which relates to sporting activities.
- Must treat Insight Community Project staff and volunteers with respect.
- Must treat other service users with respect.
- Will arrive promptly to sessions where activities are planned.
