RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work directly with the Vice President of Standards (VPS) and have structured bi-weekly 1:1s coaching and supporting this officer.
- Become educated on Fraternity Headquarter Standards Board resources and confirm the chapter recruits and trains a Standards Board following each election cycle.
- Confirm the Responsible Sig Program is facilitated within seven (7) days of the start of the fall term.
- Confirm the VPS is aware of and upholds all rules & policies of the fraternity.
- Understand and teach Roberts Rules of Order to the chapter annually.
- Confirm the VPS is knowledgeable on all Alpha Sigma Phi guidelines, including the Amnesty Policy and Health & Safety guidelines and meets with every new member class to review both.
- Assist the VPS with coordinating one educational program related to health & safety utilizing a guest presenter, outside of Responsible Sig.
- Participate in all Chapter Council meetings, as scheduled by the Chapter Advisor.
