Notice to all Menoken Water District customers:
To ensure future water supply for the valley, The Project 7 Water Authority is planning to construct a new treatment plant near Ridgway Reservoir, the Project 7 Water Authority Board of Directors has instituted a 2 -year rate increase on treated water sold to the District in 2024 and 2025. Menoken Water District will be passing on these price increases to our customers in 2024 and 2025. Our rate for 2024 starting on January $1^{\text {st }}$ will be $\$ 3.98$ per 1,000 gallons or $\$ .40$ per 100 gallons. For most customers it will amount to $\$ 1.00$ to 3.00 dollars per month increase.
