he Mayors of Austria's four major cities -- Vienna, Salzburg, Graz and Innsbruck -- are inviting select American groups to perform in the American Celebration of Music in Austria concert series.

The American Celebration of Music is a special annual performance-tour program, co-sponsored by local governments, music associations, community organizations, and tourist boards around the globe. In many countries this has developed into a prestigious, recognized, year-long concert-series festival. Recognition of this festival facilitates greater access to performance venues, official publicity, generally very successful concert arrangements, and the ability to touch local cultures in a way that may not be done through other affiliations. This equates to more meaningful musical and emotional experiences for participating performance ensembles.

Austria is so steeped in music that musicians the world over consider a performance tour here as a musical pilgrimage to the cradle of Western Civilization's musical heritage. To combine performances in exciting and historical venues with on-the-spot exposure to the music of the Masters is an enriching musical and educational experience.

Gluck, Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert, Bruckner, Brahms, Strauss, Mahler, Schoenberg, Herbert von Karajan, Karl Böhm and numerous other musical personalities were all Austrian by birth or adoption. Vienna was their home. Their music influenced the entire world. Festival participants see their homes, their manuscripts, their musical instruments, venues of their incredible performances, and walk in their footsteps. Picture your choir singing in Salzburg Cathedral, your orchestra performing in Vienna's Konzerthaus, your band playing in Mirabell Gardens! All of this can happen and more for participants in the American Celebration of Music in Austria!



# Suggested Itinerary SALZBURG / MONDSEE / MELK / VIENNA

#### DAY ONE: ARRIVE

Depart via scheduled air service to Munich, Germany

#### DAY TWO: MUNICH / SALZBURG

#### Arrive in Munich

Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to the awaiting motorcoach for a transfer to Salzburg

Take a panoramic *Sound of Music* city tour of Salzburg, including important movie sights such Mirabell Palace and Gardens, and the famed Gazebo located at Hellbrunn Palace

Check into a conveniently located hotel

Welcome Dinner and overnight

#### DAY THREE: SALZBURG

Enjoy a morning guided tour of Salzburg including Mirabell Palace and Gardens, Mozart Square, the Dom (cathedral), University Church, entrance to the Mozarthaus (Mozart's birthplace) and a cable car ride up to the Fortress (for an unparalleled view of the city below)

#### For Choirs only: Sing recital in Salzburg Dom

For Instrumental groups only: Clinic with Faculty of the Mozarteum Performance as part of the American Celebration of Music in Austria

#### DAY FOUR: SALZBURG / MONDSEE / MELK / VIENNA

Transfer to Mondsee to visit St. Michael's Church (site of *The Sound* of *Music* wedding)

Continue to Melk to visit the world-famous Abbey (*where choirs may sing a short recital*). The Abbey of Melk which crowns a rocky bluff overlooking the Danube more than 150 ft. above the river, is the apogee of Baroque architecture in Austria Continue to Vienna

#### DAY FIVE: VIENNA

Half-day guided tour of *Historical Vienna* includes the Ringstráße, Imperial Palace, State Opera, Town Hall, Burgkapelle (home of the Vienna Boys Choir), Palace Stables, Strauß Monument, and entrance to Schönbrunn Palace, built by the Hapsburgs in imitation of Versailles *Performance as part of the American Celebration of Music in Austria* 

#### DAY SIX: VIENNA

#### For choirs: Sing recital at St. Stephen's Cathedral

Half-day guided tour of Musical Vienna includes entrance to the Haus der Musik (House of Music), a modern interactive sound museum located in the historic city center. This tour also includes the Museum of the Vienna Philharmonic, which is part of the House of Music. The Musical Vienna tour concludes with a visit (entrance included) to the Beethoven Heligenstadt apartment

Time permitting; enjoy a visit to the Vienna City Cemetery to visit the graves of Beethoven, Strauss, Brahms, Schubert and the Mozart Memorial Evening Farewell Dinner and overnight

DAY SEVEN: DEPART FOR HOME Transfer to Vienna's airport for the return flight
